SURFACE Preparation	The specifications below are for plaster, cement, concrete, cement sheeting, brickwork and wood surfaces.
	 Surfaces must be dry and moisture content of surface should not be more than 10 % when measured with a moisture meter.
	Surfaces must be free of dirt, dust, grease, oil and loose paint.
	UNPAINTED SURFACES
	Scrape or brush down to remove any loose growths.
	Swab with solution prepared in accordance with thinning instructions.
	Allow to dry.
	Brush down and apply the appropriate painting system.
	SURFACES PREVIOUSLY PAINTED WITH GLOSS, EGGSHELL, FLAT FINISH OR EMULSION PAINTS
	 If the paint film is heavily infected, it should be removed completely using paint remover or other suitable means. Then treat as an unpainted surface.
	• If the contamination is only a light surface infection, remove all dirt and grease with a warm detergent solution. Rinse with clean water and remove any loose material by scraping or glass
	papering. Treat as for unpainted surfaces. WITH SOFT DISTEMPER
	Remove as far as possible all previous coatings by washing with warm detergent solution. Pince with along vector and allow to dry. Pince with along vector and allow to dry.
	Rinse with clean water and allow to dry. Treat as for uppointed surfaces.
	 Treat as for unpainted surfaces. WITH CEMENT PAINT
	Remove all loose material by scraping and bristle brushing.

	Permoglaze Fungicidal Treatment cannot be used as a paint additive.		
	• In severe cases of mould/algae attacks, no fungicidal treatment will give complete protection on		
	its own. It is then necessary to apply a total system of anti-mould grade paints such as Permoglaze		
	Anti-Fungus Emulsion.		
	• For maximum effectiveness, every coat should be in this grade, e.g. primer and undercoat as well		
	as the finishing coat.		
	 Anti-mould grades incorporate fungicides, one specially selected for water- based paints, another 		
	for solvent-based paints. Both fungicides are of low toxicity to human beings and animals, but		
	deadly to a wide variety of mould and algae.		
	 Normal performance properties of Permoglaze primers and paints are not changed by the addition 		
	of the fungicides.		
PACKAGING	Available in 1, 5 & 20 litres		
STORAGE	Keep in a cool, dry place and away from heat sources.		
SAFETY, HEALTH &	Handle with care		
ENVIRONMENT INFORMATION	Ensure good ventilation during application.		
	 In case of insufficient ventilation during painting, wear suitable respiratory equipment. 		
	Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
